Graduation Details

1. When is Clovis High's graduation?

Clovis High's graduation will take place **Wednesday, May 30th at 7:30pm** in Lamonica Stadium.

2. I've heard tickets are required, is this true? Is there a limit to the number of people who can attend?

No. Tickets are NOT required for general seating. Seating is first come first serve on the North Side of Lamonica.

3. What is the dress code for graduation?

Students should be in CUSD Dress code at all times. This is a formal type event and professional type dress is required, including dress shoes. Denim and tennis shoes are NOT allowed. Students may wear CHS accessories only and are limited to the CSF Gold Cord, Top 20 Medallion, and the National Honors Society Sash. Cap and Gown is required with tassel.

(Students who have a question regarding specific attire can ask the Deputy Principal's office.)

4. Do Advanced Studies Scholars of Distinction, Top 20, and CSF Lifetime Members receive tickets for VIP seating?

Yes. Advanced Studies Scholars of Distinction, Top 20, and CSF Lifetime Members are provided 4 VIP seating tickets. These will be provided to the student at the Senior Banquet held at Tornino's on Wednesday, May 16th.

5. When do students order their graduation supplies (caps, gowns, announcements, keepsakes, etc.)?

[Graduate Services](#) will be meeting with seniors and distributing order forms on Friday, November 17th in Govt/Econ classes. Extra order forms can be picked up in the Activities Office.

Graduate Services will return to CHS (Activities Office) on Nov. 29th and Nov. 30th from 11:00am-3:15 to collect orders, answer questions, and process payments.
