### Clovis Community College Center Advantage Program (CCCAP)

CCCAP students take 2 pre-identified transferable courses per semester at the Clovis Community Herndon Campus (transportation provided). Students who successfully complete all 4 courses will earn 12 general education (GE) college credits and 20 high school elective credits. Classes are held on M/W/F afternoons from 1pm - 3pm.

**Courses: Art 2 - Art Appreciation; Psychology 2 - General Psychology; History 1 - Western Civilization to 1648; Sociology 1A - Introduction to Sociology.**

- 12th grade student on track for graduation with a 2.5 GPA or above.
- Approval from parents, principal, and HS counselor.
- Must be enrolled in at least 4 classes at CHS

- Enrollment Fees are WAIVED
- Student must purchase textbooks

Student must indicate interest in CCCAP during Registration in spring of junior year.

### Clovis Community College Enrichment Program

The Clovis Community College High School Enrichment Program offers students in 10th, 11th, and 12th grades an opportunity to enroll in college courses and receive college credit for up to two courses per semester. Completion of the Clovis Community Placement Test is required prior to enrolling in select courses. Transportation is not provided and students do not receive high school credit for classes taken through Enrichment. Evening courses are available.

- 11th and 12th grade student on track for graduation with a 2.5 GPA or above
- 10th grade student on track for graduation with a 3.0 GPA or above
- Approval from parents, principal, and HS counselor.

- Enrollment Fees are WAIVED
- Student must purchase textbooks

A new enrichment packet must be submitted each semester. State Center Community College District (SCCCD) Admission Application is available October 1st for spring, & April 1 for summer/fall.

### Clovis Community College Summer Scholars Advanced College Academy (SSACA)

Summer Scholars offers future 10th, 11th, and 12th graders the opportunity to enroll in summer courses at Clovis Community College. Students may complete up to 2 courses during the 6 week summer session. Students may earn "Dual Credit" for ONE course. Courses available for dual credit are marked with an (\*) on the [Summer Scholars Flyer](#). Dual credit means students may earn 3-5 college credits (on SCCCDD transcript) and 5 elective credits (on CUSD transcript).

- Future 10th with 3.0 GPA or above.
- Future 11th and 12th with 2.5 GPA or above.

### Advanced Placement (AP) Program

AP classes offer a challenging and stimulating educational experience for college bound students. When compared to other high school courses, AP classes often take more time, require more work, and give greater opportunity for individual growth and accomplishment. In May, AP exams are taken and scored on a 5 point scale. Most major colleges and universities recognize scores of 3, 4, or 5 for college credit. The amount of credit varies by institution. **Clovis High currently offers 17 AP classes.**

- 10th, 11th, and 12th grade students.

AP classes are free, but there is a \$94 fee to take the AP exam, plus a 1 time \$5 admin fee.  
Financial assistance is available for those who qualify.

Students must indicate interest in AP classes during Registration in the spring.  
Most AP classes will have a summer assignment that needs to be completed prior to the first day of school.

### Dual Enrollment Classes

**CTE Education Careers** - In the spring, students will enroll in Education 10 - Introduction to Teaching, an online course through Clovis Community College. Students will earn 3 college credits, 10 HS English credits, and 10 high school elective credits.

**CTE Careers with Children** - In the fall, students will enroll in Child Development 1 - Principles and Practices of Teaching Young Children, an online course through Clovis Community College. Students earn 3 college credits and 20 high school elective credits.

**ERWC/English 1A** - 12th grade students take ERWC in the fall and Engl 1A in the spring. Students may earn 4 college credits for Engl 1A and 10 high school English credits. Class is taught at Clovis High.

**CTE Programs: Fire Fighting Technology, Building Scaled Structures, and Engine Technology** - Dual Enrollment courses are available in the above CTE courses for eligible students. Instructors will provide information on enrolling for college credit.

**CART Interactive Game Design**- Students will be enrolled in IS 50A in the fall and IS 50B in the spring. Students 3 units of college credit per semester.

- CTE Education Careers open to 12th grade students with a 2,5 GPA.
- CTE Careers with Children open to 11th and 12th grades students with 2.5.
- ERWC/English 1A is only open to 12th grade students.
- CTE courses open to 11th and 12th grade students.
- CART Interactive Game Design is open to returning seniors with 2.5 GPA.

Student must indicate interest in dual enrollment classes during Spring Registration at Clovis High School.

# Uni-track College Credit Opportunity

**CHS AP Chemistry Dual Enrollment** - Students who take AP Chemistry and elect to register for Uni-track may earn college credit through Fresno State. Students will earn HS and college credit. Upon completion of the course, students may request a college transcript from Fresno State verifying credits earned.

**CART Environmental Research and Technology** - Students may elect to register for Uni-track may earn college credit through Fresno State. Students will earn HS and college credit. Upon completion of the course, students may request a college transcript from Fresno State verifying credits earned.
