Bring your photos to Mr. Craig in E-09 by Nov. 17th. Any size picture is acceptable. Must be a high quality print. **Emailed photos will not be accepted.**

3. What are the guidelines for photos taken by private photographers?

Portraits taken by private photographers are acceptable as they meet the same standards as Larson Brothers. Students must be in [dress code](#). No props are allowed in the photo. Outdoor shots are acceptable. Remember, all photos must be in good taste.
