A. TO QUALIFY FOR CSF MEMBERSHIP FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES:

1. You must earn a minimum of 10 points
 - a. 4 POINTS MUST BE FROM LIST I (unless you are a senior applying for membership in February or June)
 - b. 7 POINTS MUST BE FROM LISTS I OR II (including the 4 points in "a")
 - c. Remaining points may come from any list (I, II, or III)
2. You must use NO MORE THAN 5 COURSES to qualify.
3. NO CSF POINTS are given for physical education, courses taken in lieu of physical education, subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving clerking and office/teacher assisting, or courses taken on a pass/fail basis.
4. CSF points are granted as follows:

Grade of "A"	=	3 CSF points *(Note: Grade of "A" in an AP, IB or UC designated "honors" course earns 4 points)
Grade of "B"	=	1 CSF point *(Note: Grade of "B" in an AP, IB or UC designated "honors" course earns 2 points)
Grade of "C"	=	0 CSF points
Grade of "D" or "F"	=	in <u>any</u> course (including courses that cannot be used to qualify) prevents membership at this time.

*Maximum of 2 extra points per semester.

B. ALSO REMEMBER:

1. Semester membership is based on work done the previous semester. Summer school courses may not be used.
2. Please attach an official copy of your previous semester's grades (either a report card or a signed transcript from the registrar, but NOT an online printout).
3. You must REAPPLY EACH SEMESTER.
4. Courses you may use are listed on the reverse, and are divided into Lists I, II and III.
5. A \$10 contribution per semester to be used for CSF activities including the CSF Life banquet, chapter dues, CSF awards, etc. Please see Ms. Perkovich or Ms. Pires for questions or concerns.
