

Steps to Completing the Community College Process

Step #1: Application

Most seniors had an opportunity to complete their community college application on September 13th in Govt/Econ classes. Any student who did not complete and/or finish the application on September 13th must submit it on their own time.



Step #2: Activate SCCCD Email Account

2-3 days after applying, check your personal email account for an email from SCCCD which will contain your community college student ID and instructions on how to activate your SCCCD email acccount.



Step #3: Complete "New Student Online Orientation" via WebAdvisor

WebAdvisor is the online system that allows students to complete orientation, register for classes, check grades, view financial aid information, etc. **The orientation will take approximately 30 to 45 minutes to complete.**
