Turn-in:

1. Bring a **neat, error-free application**, written in **blue or black pen**, or typed.
2.
 - a. **Four points** must be from **List 1**.
 - b. **Seven points** must be from **Lists 1 or 2**, including the **four points** from List 1
 - c. **Stop listing classes** when you have reached **10 points**.
 - d. **Only 2 extra points TOTAL** may be added for **AP/Honors classes** (in the overall count of the ten points).
3. Bring a **COPY OF YOUR REPORT CARD** with the **most recently completed semester grades**, or bring a **transcript**. Please be aware that we will be keeping the copy of your report card or transcript with your application.

A printout from Zangle WILL NOT be accepted as proof of your most recently completed semester grades!

4. Bring a \$10 contribution (cash or check made out to CLOVIS UNIFIED) to be used for CSF activities including the CSF Life banquet, chapter dues, CSF awards, etc. Please see Mrs. Aalto or Miss Perkovich for questions or concerns.

→ Please do **NOT** put your cash or check in an envelope **OR** put it in the teacher's box or leave it with another teacher, school secretary, etc.

A. TO QUALIFY FOR CSF MEMBERSHIP FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES:

1. You must earn a minimum of 10 points
 - a. 4 POINTS MUST BE FROM LIST I (unless you are a senior applying for membership in February or June)
 - b. 7 POINTS MUST BE FROM LISTS I OR II (including the 4 points in "a")
 - c. Remaining points may come from any list (I, II, or III)
2. You must use NO MORE THAN 5 COURSES to qualify.
3. NO CSF POINTS are given for physical education, courses taken in lieu of physical education, subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving clerking and office/teacher assisting, or courses taken on a pass/fail basis.
4. CSF points are granted as follows:

Grade of "A"	=	3 CSF points *(Note: Grade of "A" in an AP, IB or UC designated "honors" course earns 4 points)
Grade of "B"	=	1 CSF point *(Note: Grade of "B" in an AP, IB or UC designated "honors" course earns 2 points)
Grade of "C"	=	0 CSF points
Grade of "D" or "F"	=	in <u>any</u> course (including courses that cannot be used to qualify) prevents membership at this time.

*Maximum of 2 extra points per semester.

B. ALSO REMEMBER:

1. Semester membership is based on work done the previous semester. Summer school courses may not be used.
2. Please attach an official copy of your previous semester's grades (either a report card or a transcript, but NOT an online printout).
3. You must REAPPLY EACH SEMESTER.
4. Courses you may use are listed on the reverse, and are divided into Lists I, II and III.
5. A \$10 contribution per semester to be used for CSF activities including the CSF Life banquet, chapter dues, CSF awards, etc. Please see Mrs. Aalto or Mrs. Phillips for questions or concerns.
