



Steps to Completing the Community College Process

Email Username:

Community college student ID number followed by @my.scccd.edu
Example: 0123456@my.scccd.edu

WebAdvisor Username:

Community college student ID number

Password:

First initial (upper case), last initial (lower case), and 6-digit date of birth
Example: John Smith would be Js122597



Step #1: Application

www.scccd.edu/apply

Seniors will complete their community college application on September 13th-14th in Govt/Econ classes. Any student who does not complete the application on either of these days must submit it on their own time.



Step #2: Activate SCCCD Email Account

2-3 days after applying, check your personal email account for an email from SCCCD which will contain your community college student ID and instructions on how to activate your SCCCD email account.



Step #3: Financial Aid: File your FAFSA October 1 - March 2.

Step #4: Complete "New Student Online Orientation" via **WebAdvisor**

webadvisor.scccd.edu/



WebAdvisor is the online system that allows students to complete orientation, register for classes, check grades, view financial aid information, etc. **The orientation will take approximately 30 to 45 minutes to complete.**
