PURPOSE	Make up failing grade(s) for grade promotion or graduation requirements. NOTE: There will be in-class instruction for <u>selected courses only</u>. Please see your counselor.
NOTIFICATION	Registration occurs at the student’s regular high school site. HS Counselor will register students. Parent Connect may be accessed to view student summer schedule in late May.
CREDIT RECOVERY ELIGIBILITY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Must be an enrolled student in CUSD. ▪ Incoming students in grades 10 – 12 that must repeat a course due to D or F. ▪ If deficient in credits/required courses for graduation.
ORIGINAL CREDIT ELIGIBILITY	General criteria for an Original Credit course in Summer School: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ An impacted schedule for the following school year and ○ 3.0 Semester GPA (unless otherwise indicated for special circumstances) and ○ Self-discipline, self-motivation, ability to work independently
LUNCH	Lunch will be provided the same as during the regular school year
ATTENDANCE	Students are required to attend the full class hours on a daily basis. Monday - Thursday ONLY 2 DAYS OF INSTRUCTION CAN BE MISSED. Work must be made up. Any further absences will result in being dropped from Summer School. Student will be dropped after 2nd absence Absence = Family vacation, court, illness, school sponsored function, sent home for dress code or conduct violation.
STUDENT CONDUCT & DRESS CODE	All Clovis Unified School District rules will be enforced during Summer School including CUSD Dress Code Conduct: Students are required to abide by the school code of conduct. Students who break California Education Code are eligible for suspension. If a student is suspended, and the resulting effect is that they miss too many classes as defined by the summer school attendance policy, will be dropped after serving their suspension. <i>Zero tolerance offenses will be referred for further disciplinary action</i> Dress Code: Students are required to comply with the district-wide dress code when attending course appointments. <i>Students will be sent home if attend school out of dress code which equals one absence</i>

IMPORTANT DATES	<p>Independent Study Summer School BEGINS Tuesday, June 8, 2021 ENDS Wednesday, July 21, 2021 All student work is to be completed and turned in to the student's teacher by 5:00pm on Wednesday, July 21, 2021.</p> <p>Tuesday and Wednesday, June 8th and June 9th Each teacher will schedule a one-hour orientation/enrollment on Tuesday or Wednesday. Any student who fails to meet their teacher on one of the orientation/enrollment days will not be guaranteed admission into Independent Study Summer School. This is also counted as the 1st week of IS.</p>
CLASS APPOINTMENTS	<p>8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Tuesday or Wednesday Scheduled weekly appointments: 1-Hour Minimum.</p>
NOTIFICATION	<p>Students should be contacted by their Independent Study Teacher close to the end of the school year. If the IS Teacher has not made contact by June 4th, please call the Independent Study Office. The Independent Study Summer School phone numbers will be posted on school/district websites.</p>
CREDIT RECOVERY ELIGIBILITY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Must be an enrolled student in CUSD. ▪ Incoming students in Grades 10 – 12 that must repeat a course due to D or F. ▪ If deficient in credits/required courses for graduation.
ORIGINAL CREDIT ELIGIBILITY	<p>Any student who needs an Original Credit course due to employment, an impacted school schedule, or special circumstance.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Must attend a comprehensive school site. ▪ Counselor will determine if student meets criteria for Original Credit. <p>General criteria for an Original Credit course in Summer School:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ An impacted schedule for the following school year and ○ 3.0 Semester GPA (unless otherwise indicated for special circumstances) and ○ Self-discipline, self-motivation, ability to work independently
HOW MANY CREDITS?	<p>9th, 10th, and 11th grade students may take 10 credits (1 full year course or 2 semester courses).</p>
ATTENDANCE	<p>Students may miss only one appointment no matter what the reason or emergency. Student will be dropped on the 2nd absence. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE!</p>
